

## **Renewing and enhancing the quality of social work education – implementing the SWRB proposals**

The workshop will commence with a brief overview of developments from the Social Work Reform Board (SWRB) in relation to social work education in England at qualifying level, focussing particularly on work since March (the end of the consultation period). The workshop will report on outcomes from HEI & employer testing of aspects of the SWRB proposals, including changes to admissions requirements, practice learning, (including the 30 days skills development) and partnership. The workshop will focus specifically on the developments for the curriculum based on the Professional Capabilities Framework. We will work in small groups to consider what this will mean for qualifying programmes and how the aim of the SWRB to produce more confident, competent social workers can be achieved. The output from the workshop will be made available to the community.
